# Appendix One

## Chemicals used in the Manufacture of Chemical Weapons

The list comprises of eleven-digit codes that respectively from left to right, the first 6-digit is the indication of the international tariff codes of a Harmonized System (HS), the seventh and the eighth digits of the code represent the section and the number of the schedule that the chemical substance belongs to and the last three digits indicates the serial number.

That is, “the Registration of the Orders” and the clearance of the chemicals numbered respectively from 1 to 174( export & import) is due to a previously authorization of the National Authority for Chemical Weapons Convention. For the Export & Import of other chemicals, the related information should be transmitted to the National Authority for Chemical Weapons Convention for data collection.

Therefore, when registering an order of items for import, it would be necessary for the applicant to select and indicate in writing the related 14 digit code and the exact chemical name of the substance in the Forms provided for the “Registry of the Orders” in the Ministry of Commerce.

# **Appendix Four**

## **Statutory Articles and Notes Concerning the Application of National Standards to Imports**

## **Preamble**

In order to implement the provisions of Note 2 of Article 6 of the law amending the laws and regulations of the Institute of Standards and Industrial Research of Iran [ISIRI] enacted in 1992 (1371) and the resolutions of the Supreme Council of Standards, goods listed herein have been made subject to mandatory standards. Thus, the importation, storage, distribution and sale of these goods having a quality inferior to the standards acceptable to the Institute are prohibited.

Importers of goods covered by the mandatory standards regulations are required to observe the pertaining regulations. In case they fail to comply with the statutory requirements, aside from the fact that they, as consumers within the community, will suffer damages, they will also be prosecuted as stipulated herein on the strength of Articles 9, 11, 12 and 14 of the law amending the laws and regulations of the Institute of Standards & Industrial Research of Iran.

The Iranian Customs Administration shall prevent, in accordance with the law and the Executive Ordinance of Export-Import Regulations, the entry of products which have been proclaimed as subject to mandatory standards but lack a certificate of conformity from the ISIRI.

### **Remarks:**

1. All sub-groups falling under tariff lines which have been distinguished by six-digit and eight-digit tariffs shall also be subject to the regulations of mandatory standards.
2. "Goods" are the focal point of mandatory standards regulations. If, for whatever reasons, covered goods are declared as falling under another tariff, or non-covered goods are declared as under tariffs contained in the list, the criterion to determine the mandatory nature is that the goods' names appear on the list. The Customs Administration and ISIRI Directorates-General at the entry points shall take note and coordinate accordingly.
3. Goods distinguished by a (COI) mark must be necessarily inspected at the origin and an Inspection Certificate be issued and presented by the inspecting company.
4. In addition to compliance with acceptable standards, goods distinguished by a (\*) mark must conform to energy consumption technical criteria and specifications, and bear an energy label.

## **Statutory Articles and Notes Concerning the Application of National Standards to Imports**

### **Article 6**

With the approval of the Supreme Council of Standards, the Institute may declare standards of goods or parts of a certain standard, or codes of practice as mandatory on the grounds of safety, public health, product quality assurance, consumer protection or other welfare and economic considerations, and may set necessary deadlines which shall not be less than three months.

**Note 2.** Depending on the necessity and priority, and with due attention to the safety, health and economic issues, the quality of imported materials and goods must conform to the national standards of the Islamic Republic of Iran or standards of the country of origin or accredited standards acceptable to the Institute.

The Supreme Council of Standards shall determine the priority of materials and goods.

### **Article 9**

Whenever the application of standards to certain goods is declared mandatory, upon the expiry of the respective deadline the

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production, storage, distribution and sale of such goods with quality inferior to the relevant standard or those lacking ISIRI mark are prohibited.

With due regard to the circumstances, scale and frequency of the offence, the offender shall be sentenced by the rulings of competent courts to various degrees of punishment ranging from serving a summons, admonition, warning, reprimand, threat or obligation letter to imprisonment from one month to two years and a pecuniary punishment from IRR one hundred thousand to IRR fifty million.

**Note 2.** Compliance with all the mandatory standards regulations applicable to imported goods shall be compulsory.

### Article 11

Whoever alters the specifications of the products covered by mandatory standards after they have been prepared, produced or manufactured, or uses the containers and packaging materials of standardized products to package, supply or sell non-standard products, or modifies, with fraudulent intentions or otherwise, the tins, packages, boxes or wrappings of the products covered by mandatory standards, or supplies or sells, instead of standardized goods, other goods under the same designation, or uses, with fraudulent intentions test sheets and test reports indicating product specification, or uses the ISIRI mark in irrelevant cases or on products without obtaining a license, shall be sentenced to imprisonment from six months to two years and a pecuniary fine of IRR one million to IRR fifty million.

**Note of Article 525 of the Islamic Penal Law (section on misdemeanour and preventive punishment):**

**Note.** Whoever uses, deliberately and without acquiring official domestic or international documents and licenses, the names and marks of national or international standards with the intention of inducing misleading information on the quality of products or services, shall be sentenced to the maximum punishment prescribed by this Article.

### Article 12

If the perpetration of one of the offences set out in this law causes an illness or injury, the perpetrator shall be sentenced to the following punishments depending on the outcome:

1. If the duration of treatment does not exceed two months, the punishment of the perpetrator shall be six months to two years imprisonment of misdemeanour nature and IRR five hundred thousand to IRR two million pecuniary fine.
2. If the duration of treatment exceeds two months, the punishment of the perpetrator shall be one to three years imprisonment of misdemeanour nature and IRR one million to IRR two million pecuniary fine.
3. If the offence causes mutilation, depending on the case, the punishment of the perpetrator shall be three to ten years imprisonment of misdemeanour nature and IRR two million to IRR five million pecuniary fine.
4. If the offence leads to death, the punishment of the perpetrator shall be three to fifteen years imprisonment of misdemeanour nature and a pecuniary fine of IRR three million to IRR ten million.

In all the above cases, if the consumer files a complaint, the blood money and injury of the consumer shall be compensated for on the basis of the Islamic Penal Law and in accordance with the verdicts of the courts, providing that the real cause is stronger than the immediate one.

### Article 14

If a producer or seller violates the regulations declared in relation to standardized goods or weights and measures or the measurement instruments, losses suffered by the customer shall be fully reimbursed by the producer or seller, as the case may be, upon the complaint of the customer and once the case has been established and a verdict issued by a competent court.
